

# Housing for Persons with Disabilities

LHA offers a variety of housing options for persons with disabilities including wheel chair accessible units at several different properties. Income and eligibility requirements vary by property.

## **Two Bedroom Houses and Duplexes**

Twelve fully accessible two bedroom houses and duplexes are available. These houses are located in various parts of the city; four units are located in Arnold Heights. These units are federally subsidized and rent is based on income. See Scattered Site Family Public Housing for additional description of unit amenities.

## **One Bedroom Apartments**

Accessible one bedroom apartments are available at all three of LHAs high rise apartment buildings: [Burke Plaza](#) (6721 L Street), [Crossroads House](#) (1001 O Street) and [Mahoney Manor](#) (4241 North 61<sup>st</sup>). Follow the links for description of unit amenities.

## **Two Bedroom Apartments**

Accessible two bedroom apartments are available at [Lynn Creek Apartments](#) (9<sup>th</sup> Street and Garber Avenue), [Wood Bridge Apartments](#) (South 22<sup>nd</sup> Street and Pine Lake Road) and [Summer Hill Apartments](#) (South 56<sup>th</sup> Street and Union Hill Road). ## **Three Bedroom Apartments**

Accessible three bedroom apartments are available at [Summer Hill Apartments](#), on the north side of Union Hill Road, west of South 56<sup>th</sup> Street.

## **Mainstream Housing Opportunities Program**

Beginning in August 2006, LHA was awarded a Mainstream Housing Opportunities Commission Program grant from HUD. The program provides 20 new vouchers to LHA to serve persons with disabilities. The five year program also gets support from agencies providing social services to persons with disabilities so they can be successful in maintaining their housing and becoming more self sufficient.
