Programs and Services

CHILD CARE CENTER: Operated by Cedars Youth Services; serves infants through 9-yr-olds; offers hourly, daily, and weekly rates. Open Monday-Friday, 6:30am-6pm. Full- and part-time care may be available. Call 402-437-8923 for more information.

FRIENDS WITH FOOD: Free food distribution on the fourth Monday of the month, 5-6 p.m. at the FRC. This is a USDA commodities distribution and families must qualify by income. *This institution is an equal opportunity provider.*

CLOTHING CLOSET: Free clothing, toys, and other items are available. The room is open from 8am-12pm and 1-5pm Monday through Friday. No appointment is necessary but you will need to sign-in at the front desk. Donations are taken during the same hours.

RESOURCE AND REFERRAL: Assistance with locating and accessing community resources to help meet basic or other needs. Call 402-434-2621 for assistance.

REDUCED-COST BUS PASSES: Monthly bus passes may be purchased at the FRC for \$8.00. Photo ID, previous month's pass, and date of birth are required. Hours for purchasing passes are Monday through Friday, 8am-12pm and 1-5pm.

SENIOR COFFEE CLUB: Meets weekly on Wednesdays from 9-10:30 a.m. at the FRC. All seniors 55+ are welcome to come for coffee, conversation and speakers. During the summer the Coffee Club will change the meeting time on Wednesday mornings to 10-11:30 a.m. This new time will start on June 5.

COMPUTER CENTER: Free RoadRunner Internet access on two computers. Scanners and printers on both computers. Must be accompanied by an adult if under 18 years old. Hours are 8am-5pm.

MEETING SPACE: Large conference room available for public groups and meetings free of charge. Evening and weekend hours available.

LINCOLN POLICE DEPARTMENT

SUBSTATION: Office space for area police officers to do paperwork and complete other duties while in Air Park neighborhoods.

VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES: Provides volunteer hours for diversion services, Gov't & Politics hours, and anyone who wants to volunteer in the community. Volunteers help with monthly food distribution, special events, and the Arnold Community Learning Center after-school programs.

CHAPEL RENTAL: The Lincoln Army Airfield Regimental Chapel in front of the Family Resource Center is available for rent through the Resource Center service coordinator for weddings, birthday and anniversary celebrations, baby and wedding showers, and other private events.

Youth Programs

ARNOLD COMMUNITY LEARNING CENTER: Provides quality, affordable before- and after-school programs at Arnold Elementary. Academic enrichment clubs are also offered at the school at no charge. Other services and activities include family nights, behavioral health support, and neighborhood outreach. EXPANDING HORIZONS ENRICHMENT PROGRAM: Free summer enrichment classes for students in grades 1-6; past workshops included art, exploring nature, science, literature, judo, drama, history, geography, music, and many others.
